




# I can't open the files. What can I do?



The files you've just purchased are compressed in an archive. Before opening them, you need to unzip this archive. In your download folder, right clic on the archive and select Extract. Then you'll be able to open the files and print them.

# I can't modify the files. What can I do?

The files you've just purchased are protected against modification, except for editable files. You need the latest Acrobat Reader version to open and print them but you may not modify them. If they're editable, then you need Powerpoint to open the files and modify them (you may only modify certain parts).

# I can't print the files. What can I do?



The files you've purchased are Powerpoint files saved as protected PDF. Sometimes, the protection provokes some printing problems. To solve this, open your files in Acrobat Reader, clic on file/print and in Advanced Options choose Print as an image  
To print twice the same page on the same sheet, clic on Multiple and write the page number twice in the page selection. Done!

# I found a typo, how can I correct it?




# A link in the file doesn't work. What can I do?

# How can I get TPT credits?



Each time you provide feedback, you get some TPT credits. A \$5 document gives you 5 credits, 20 credits are worth \$1. You can save for future purchases! Free products don't give you credits, but it's polite to provide feedback. Providing negative feedback on freebies is considered rude though.

## What is feedback?


Once you've purchased a document, it appears (forever!) in your My Purchases menu. Just below the name of the document is a green thumb and a link to provide feedback. Here are TPT rules:

After downloading and evaluating, please provide a fair rating.

Fair means that you have read the product description carefully and know what the seller was offering (and therefore what they were not). If you had trouble downloading or opening, don't leave a bad rating, contact us for assistance first. And if there was a simple error in the product, for example, a typo or two or something of this nature, please Ask the seller to fix it for you before leaving a bad rating!

Once again if you need anything regarding one of your purchases, please reach out to me **BEFORE** leaving a bad rating. I can improve the documents with your help!

FYI: 6As is 4/4 ; 6B+s is 3,5/4 ; 6Bs is 3/4 etc...


# I bought a document and would love to share it at school. Can I?



The files you've purchased are for personal use in a classroom by a single teacher. You can of course use them in as many classes as you have but you may not copy them and give to a colleague. But if you wish to share you can buy additional licences for your colleagues (at a discounted price). If you have many colleagues, please [Contact](#) me!

# I would love to publish your work on my school's website or my personal blog. Can I?

The files you've purchased are not to be shared online, I'm sorry. However, you may publish them on a secured platform for your students (only, not for your colleagues).


I love one of your lesson on your blog but can't find it on your store. Why?
